Job Description

This is a dynamic role that offers the opportunity to develop skills in academic advising, event planning, and student services. Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Provide general academic advisement to undergraduate Accounting and Accounting & Finance majors, as well as Accounting minors
- Attend weekly staff meetings
- Help manage the general advising email account and assist with student inquiries
- Support student programs such as the Leventhal Accounting Cohort and the Leventhal Transfer Program and other academic events
- Assist with the creation and maintenance of materials such as newsletters, handbooks, online scholarship applications, fact sheets, and website content
- Other duties may be assigned as needed.

Required Qualifications

- Current enrollment in a graduate program, preferably Rossier's EC or PASA programs
- Excellent written and verbal skills
- Must be available to work 3 4 days per week (approximately 15 20 hours per week)
- Must attend all training sessions (dates TBD)
- Preferred qualities: Positive attitude, strong work ethic, team-oriented, critical thinker, quick learner, able to thrive under pressure; experience with Excel and familiarity with Canvas preferred.
- Work-study eligible preferred
- Position is hybrid, with both in-person and online hours
