About the Multicultural Center

The goal of the Multicultural Center is to offer rich cultural experiences for students, staff, and faculty to discover and celebrate the diversity of backgrounds, cultures, and traditions that represent the Mt. SAC community. Our space welcomes everyone and can be used for studying, resting or lounging, official student club events, cultural events, community celebrations, and other activities as they align with diversity, equity, inclusion, social justice, anti-racism, accessibility, and more.

About the Equity Center

The Equity Center, which opened its doors in Fall 2019, is a resource center that offers various academic and support services to all students, such as study areas, a computer lab, free printing, snacks and referrals to Basic Needs, academic counseling, tutoring, office hours with faculty, and more.
