

Transfer Center/ Transfer Mentor

(Career Guidance Counselor Assistant) 2019-2020 Academic Year

Center Description:

The East Los Angeles College Transfer Center serves as the focal point by which students, staff, and faculty are informed about the transfer process. The Transfer Center provides a variety of services, resources, and programs designed to assist students in every step of the transfer process.

Transfer Mentor Description:

Under the direct supervision of the Transfer Center Director/Transfer Center Counselors, the Transfer Mentor serves a critical role in guiding, monitoring, and mentoring ELAC students during their transfer process. Successful candidates will have strong listening, organizational, presentation, and research skills. Candidates must have initiative, motivation, and a strong desire to help first-generation college students discover their academic, career, and transfer goals. Applicants must be able to work with frequent interruptions in a dynamic, high-volume office.

Requirements:

- Must be enrolled full-time as graduate student in a ACS WASC accredited Master's degree program in counseling, rehabilitation counseling, clinical psychology, counseling psychology, guidance counseling, educational counseling, social work (MSW) or career development.
- □ Must be available to work 16-19 hours per week between the hours of 8am-7pm (at least one evening shift) and may include some Saturday mornings.
- Preferred, but not required: completion of courses in Counseling Theory, Student Development Theory, and/or Career Counseling Theories
- Skilled and proficient in using MS Word, Excel, PowerPoint, Google Docs, and other publishing software.

Job Duties:

- Develop, update, and facilitate transfer related workshops and in-class presentations.
- Provide drop-in advising support for students seeking transfer guidance.
- Assist students with their transfer applications (CSU, UC, Private and Out of State) and troubleshoot application portals, and support students with their personal statement development.
- Assist students in evaluating their transfer options as it relates to their values and interests.
- Help with collecting data from workshops, applications, and other sources to develop transfer reports.
- Attend professional development opportunities: UC & CSU transfer conferences
- Assist the Transfer Center in recruiting students for ELAC's summer transfer residential programs

Compensation:

This is a temporary paid position contingent upon funding \$20.29 per hour
