- Fosters persistence and completion by maintaining a caseload of Guardian Scholars students
- Reviews student files each semester to see if education plan is up-to-date, required documents have been submitted, and to check student progress
- Assist with events such as the Guardian Scholars Link Up events, Collaborative Meetings, Workshops and special projects as needed
- Supports with the daily activities of the program
